

Corrections to Site and Storage Conditions for Aerosols

Corrections are required to the *Site and Storage Conditions for Aerosols* published by ERMA New Zealand on 1 July 2006.

There are errors in the definitions of **area of high intensity land use** and **area of low intensity land use**.

The amended definitions are:

area of high intensity land use—

- (a) includes—
 - (i) an area of regular habitation; and
 - (ii) a structure made of or containing combustible materials that would sustain a significant fire; and
 - (iii) a high density traffic route; but
- (b) does not include a small office constructed of non-combustible materials associated with a hazardous substance location that is used by persons authorised to be at the location by the person in charge of that location

area of low intensity land use—

- (a) includes—
 - (i) an area where any person may be legally present occasionally; and
 - (ii) a public park or reserve; and
 - (iii) a traffic route of low or medium traffic density; but
- (b) does not include an area of regular habitation

The *Site and Storage Conditions for Aerosols* will be amended in accordance with the requirements of the Act. In the interim, users of this document should be aware of these corrections.
