

## Correction to group standards for cleaning products

Two corrections are required to the corrosive cleaning products group standards regarding the condition for child resistant packaging. These are:

1. Clause 9(1) should specify both a mass and quantity limit. Currently only a volume limit is provided;
2. Subclause 9(2), which was included in the consultation on these group standards, has been inadvertently omitted from the final group standards. This subclause needs to be incorporated.

The two group standards affected by these omissions are:

- Cleaning Products (Corrosive) Group Standard 2006, and
- Cleaning Products (Oxidising [5.1.1], Corrosive) Group Standard 2006.

These group standards will be amended in accordance with the requirements of the Act. In the interim, users of these group standards should be aware of these corrections.

When amended, the condition for child resistant packaging for the two corrosive cleaning products group standards will read (amended text in bold):

### 9 Child resistant packaging

- (1) When a substance is packaged in quantities of less than 2.5 L **or 2.5 kg, other than when that substance is an automatic dishwashing preparation**, that package must be child resistant, unless being sold or supplied to a place of work where children do not have access and the substance is for use in that place of work.
- (2) **Despite subclause (1), in the case of a substance that is an automatic dishwashing preparation, when that substance is packaged in quantities of less than 5 L or 5 kg, that package must be child resistant, unless being sold or supplied to a place of work where children do not have access and the substance is for use in that place of work.**
