POISON WARNING

Target Pest Contracting Ltd advises of its intention to apply by aerial application the deadly poisons Sodium monofluoroacetate (1080) and Potassium cyanide (Feratox) for the control of possums on approved lands in the following areas:

AREAS: All the land on the Hohonu Range and Three Mile Hill, and in the Greenstone, Taramakau Settlement, Mitchells and Inchbonnie areas, enclosed within the boundaries described as follows:

Block 1: The area enclosed by the Taramakau Settlement Road on the west, Kumara-Inchbonnie Road to the north, the Orangipuku River to the east and the Taramakau River to the south. It includes all or part of the Hohonu Forest Conservation Area, Orangipuku Scenic Reserve, Lake Brunner Scenic Reserve, Hohonu Scenic Reserve, Three Mile Amenity area and Revell Terrace Amenity area, as well as some private land.

Block 2: The area enclosed by the Eastern Hohonu River on the west and north, Lake Brunner on the east and the Kumara-Inchbonnie Road to the south. It includes parts of the Hohonu Forest Conservation Area, Hohonu River Conservation area as well as some private land.

Block 3: The area enclosed by the Greenstone or Big Hohonu River to the north, the Taramakau Settlement Road to the east, and the Taramakau River to the south and west. It includes all or parts of the Three Mile Amenity area, Greenstone River Conservation area, Paines

Block 1: The area enclosed by the Taramakau Settlement Road on the west, Kumara-Inchbonnie Road to the north, the Orangipuku River to the east and the Taramakau River to the south. It includes all or part of the Hohonu Forest Conservation Area, Orangipuku Scenic Reserve, Lake Brunner Scenic Reserve, Hohonu Scenic Reserve, Three Mile Amenity area and Revell Terrace Amenity area, as well as some private land.

Block 2: The area enclosed by the Eastern Hohonu River on the west and north, Lake Brunner on the east and the Kumara-Inchbonnie Road to the south. It includes parts of the Hohonu Forest Conservation Area, Hohonu River Conservation area as well as some private land.

Block 3: The area enclosed by the Greenstone or Big Hohonu River to the north, the Taramakau Settlement Road to the east, and the Taramakau River to the south and west. It includes all or parts of the Three Mile Amenity area, Greenstone River Conservation area, Paines Gully Wildlife Management Reserve, Paines Gully Road Conservation area, Paines Gully Scenic Reserve and Otira/Taramakau Conservation area, as well as some private land.

All poison baits are dyed green for bird protection and public notification.

BAIT: 1080 impregnated cereal pellets, 1080 treated carrot bait, Micro-encapsulated cyanide.

DATE: From 1st June, 2007 or as soon as practical thereafter.
