Purpose:	To field test, in Waikato, genetically modified cattle with extra bovine genes, the insertion of the human myelin basic protein gene, and the deletion of the bovine beta-lactoglobulin gene. Genes will be expressed in the milk of the cattle.
Date decision notified:	18 November 1999 (Part I) and 23 May 2001 (Part II)

Proposed amendment details

GMF98009 Part I:

This approval was amended in November 2008 to permit AgResearch to hold the GM cattle after the expiry of the approval whilst decisions on new applications were pending. AgResearch now seeks an amendment to delete from **control 1.17** the condition that “*However, no further breeding or production of any progeny may be initiated.*”

GMF98009 Part II:

This approval is due to expire on 23 May 2010, being nine years from the date of the decision. AgResearch seeks to amend **control 6.4** to extend the expiry date for the approval to 30 September 2012.
