

Pesticides Transitional Approved Handler Declaration

This declaration is made in relation to Regulation 6 of the Hazardous Substances and New Organisms (Personnel Qualifications) Regulations 2001. It is provided for handlers of pesticides (a list of tracked chemicals is included). This includes those manufacturing, storing, distributing, using and disposing of pesticides.

4. Safe Use of Pesticides

I have completed the following training on the safe handling and use of pesticides. *(If you have completed any formal courses attach any course certificates to this declaration). NOTE: this section is voluntary.*

By signing this declaration I confirm that I meet the requirements of the transitional qualification requirements for an Approved Handler under Regulation 6 Hazardous Substances and New Organisms (Personnel Qualifications) Regulations 2001 and can be regarded an Approved Handler of Pesticides for the substances and lifecycles specified. *Note: A copy of this regulation is printed on the reverse of this form. You must have been working under, and be familiar with, the previous legislation to qualify for this transitional certificate.*

This declaration is only valid until 31 December 2006. A full five year Approved Handler certificate is required after this date. You should obtain the full certificate as soon as possible.

Regulation 6 Transitional Qualification for Approved Handlers (Hazardous Substances and New Organisms (Personnel Qualifications) Regulations 2001

NOTE: The Acts listed below only include those which apply to the use of pesticides. For this declaration you should have been working previously under one of these Acts, and have understood the relevant law.

- 1) *Regulation 5 does not apply to, any person who establishes that he or she has, during the whole of any period referred to in subclause (2), been handling the hazardous substance concerned, or any other substance with similar hazardous properties, in the relevant phase of its lifecycle under 1 or more of the following Acts:*
 - (a) *Health and Safety in Employment Act 1992:*
 - (b) *Pesticides Act 1979:*
 - (c) *Toxic Substances Act 1979:*
- 2) *For the purposes of subclause (1), a **period** is any consecutive 2-year period commencing on or after the [2 July 1999].*

NOTE: This is a plain English version of subclause (2).

IMPORTANT! Keep this declaration in a safe place.

This Transitional Declaration is proof of your experience as an Approved Handler. You will need to provide a copy to your supplier when you purchase tracked pesticides and if requested by an enforcement officer.

You do not need to send a copy to ERMA New Zealand

Guidelines to using the Transitional Approved Handler Declaration - Pesticides -

Approved Handlers are needed for many pesticides under the Hazardous Substances and New Organisms (HSNO) Act. In addition some of the highly hazardous pesticides also require tracking. To purchase (or receive) a tracked substance will require you to prove you are an Approved Handler.

This form is to be used by people who wish to become Approved Handlers under the transitional provisions of the HSNO Regulations ('deemed' to be an Approved Handler). It is only applicable for Approved Handlers that wish to use substances that were previously registered pesticides, and in particular those substances transferred to the HSNO legislation on 1 July 2004.

Notes:

1. The form is only for a transitional qualification that will last for two years. All transitional qualifications will expire on 31 December 2006.
2. By completing this form you are declaring that you meet the requirements of the regulations, i.e.
 - a. You have two years experience handling the pesticides and are competent to handle them. This experience has been since July 1999.
 - b. You are knowledgeable of the previous legislation that applied to the use of pesticides.
 - c. You understand their hazards and the precautions you need to take when using them.
3. The form is designed to lead you through these requirements so that you can assess whether you meet them.
4. When the form has been completed you do not need to send it to anyone. However, in order to purchase tracked pesticides you will need to produce it to your supplier. You will also need to produce it on demand to an enforcement officer.
5. Before 31 December 2006 you must convert from this transitional qualification to a full Approved Handler qualification that lasts for five years. To do this you will need to become familiar with the relevant HSNO legislation and provide evidence of this, and your competence, to a Test Certifier. This form can provide some of the information that a Test Certifier will need to issue a full Approved Handler certificate.
6. A list of the substances which require Approved Handlers, and those that are tracked, is on the reverse of these guidelines.



Pesticides Requiring Approved Handler and Tracking Controls

This paper lists (alphabetically by trade name) transferred pesticides that are required to be under the control of an **Approved Handler** and **Tracked**. These products were transferred to the Hazardous Substances and New Organisms (HSNO) Act on 1 July 2004.

For the majority of these pesticides, the Approved Handler and Tracking controls apply regardless of the amount of the product being sold or handled. However, for some of these pesticides the controls apply only if the amount of the product contained in a package is **greater than** the amount specified in brackets after the trade name.

Products that have the approved handler control only are not included in this list. For further information on the transfer of pesticides, including the list of pesticides requiring an approved handler only, as well as a link to the Hazardous Substances Register see: <http://www.ermanz.govt.nz/hs/transfer-pesticides.asp>.

This list records substances which have been transferred to the HSNO Act and may not include all trade names. The list **does not** include new substances which have been approved under Part V of the Act which may also require tracking or approved handlers.
