1. Applicant name / Company name - In some cases this will differ from the ownership of the Stationary Container System, e.g. oil company tanks at a privately owned or franchised service station or depot.
2. Contact person - May be the Person in Charge but must possess sufficient decision-level responsibility and technical knowledge. The Authority will in the first instance contact this person should they wish to seek further clarification or further information concerning an application.
3. Name of Test Certifier - the Test Certifier that is engaged to carry out an inspection of a Stationary Container System must be registered for this activity. Once a Compliance Plan has been approved by the Authority the Test Certifier may issue a Stationary Container System Test Certificate subject to the conditions specified in the approval. The Test Certificate must only be issued for the period specified by the Authority
